OUR 2023 BUILD SITE

Blue Water Habitat has built and repaired homes in both St. Clair and Sanilac Counties for 33 years in 2023. Our most recent completed home was in the Yale community and now we will be back in Port

Huron in 2023. Through the generous support of one of our partners, the City of Port Huron, we will be starting our new build project on the corner of 12th Street and Lapeer. The property is, of course, located adjacent from KIND Park, which was the center hub for Rock the Block 2022. Volunteers helped clear the property and we will be removing trees from its center, that are unfortunately in the process of dying. This will make the property viable for a new 3-bedroom home to meet the need of the family that will one day live there. The home, like all the homes we build within the city limits of Port Huron, will have a garage as well. Though the new build will have a Lapeer address, the driveway will be accessible from 12th Street for a safer access for the family. We are excited about our new project

and thankful to our donors and volunteers for their continued support. None of the great work we do in our community would be possible without them.
